BACK IN REALITY, Jane, Xo and Raf exchange wide-eyed looks. /END

LATER: A HOT MANNY is in the interview seat.

XIOMARA  
So, you've done this before?

We WHIP: A MAGICAL NANNY CAM VIEW of the living room as Xo and Hot Manny get it on while Mateo watches with glee.

BACK IN REALITY, Jane looks over at Xo, who shakes her head no. Nothing good can come of that. Next!

LATER: A kindly Latina in her 60s, JOSEFINA "CHEPA" ABANA.
